Biodiversity


There is so much life in the rainforest:






3,000 types of fish

Some are 2,000 year old!




Jaguars

It's not a hairbrush... It's a monkey brush!




Sloths

The green anaconda is the largest snake in the world! It eats deer, birds and even jaguars!




Cockroaches




Playground Challenge!







Can you find these plants and leaves?

Outdoor Nature Crown
